

David Legates

Dr. Legates is a Professor of Climatology at the University of Delaware. He also is an adjunct faculty in the Statistics Department and the Physical Ocean Science and Engineering Program. He received his B.A. in Mathematics and Geography (double major – *cum laude*) at the University of Delaware in 1982 and a Ph.D. in Climatology from the University of Delaware in 1988. He spent 9½ years as a professor at the University of Oklahoma and 1½ years as a professor at Louisiana State University before returning to the University of Delaware in 1999. He is recognized as a Certified Consulting Meteorologist by the American Meteorological Society and is the recipient of the 2002 *Boeing Autometric Award* in Image Analysis and Interpretation by the American Society of Photogrammetry and Remote Sensing.
