HERE ARE REPORTED SNOWFALL TOTALS FROM TODAYS UNSEASONABLE SNOWFALL. IN MUCH OF THE AREA...THIS IS THE EARLIEST SIGNIFICANT SNOWFALL OF THE WINTER SEASON. THESE REPORTS ARE GENERALLY FROM EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCIES...LAW ENFORCEMENT...FIRE STATIONS AND COOPERATIVE OBSERVERS. WE THANK THESE PEOPLE FOR THEIR EFFORTS TODAY.

ACCORDING TO MEDIA AND POWER COMPANY REPORTS...THERE WERE 83000 HOMES AND BUSINESSES AROUND SOUTHEAST LOUISIANA WITHOUT POWER AS OF 1130 AM DUE TO THE SNOW. NUMEROUS VEHICULAR ACCIDENTS WERE REPORTED...SOME CAUSING EXTENDED CLOSURES AND DELAYS ON MAJOR HIGHWAYS AND BRIDGES...ESPECIALLY FROM THE BATON ROUGE AREA TO HAMMOND.

MOST LOCATIONS THAT RECEIVED 2 INCHES OR LESS SNOW EXPERIENCED COMPLETE MELTING THIS AFTERNOON...WHILE AREAS WITH THE HEAVIER SNOW AMOUNTS REPORTED SUBSTANTIAL SNOW REMAINING ON THE GROUND AS OF THIS EVENING.

AN UNUSUALLY STRONG AND COLD UPPER LEVEL STORM SYSTEM FOR THE GULF COAST AREA MOVED RIGHT OVER SOUTHEAST LOUISIANA AND EXTREME SOUTH MISSISSIPPI THIS MORNING...AND THIS RESULTED IN COOLING THE SURFACE TEMPERATURES JUST ENOUGH TO CHANGE THE MODERATE AND HEAVY RAIN OVER TO MODERATE TO HEAVY SNOW. THE HEAVIEST SNOW OCCURRED OVER THE FLORIDA PARISHES OF EAST CENTRAL AND SOUTHEAST LOUISIANA...FROM EAST OF BATON ROUGE TO THE PEARL RIVER...AND ALONG AND NORTH OF INTERSTATE 12.
