



United States Highlights

Another very wet system moved out of the plains and Mid-Mississippi Valley into the Delta and Corn Belt. Core rains currently IN, IL, OH. Temperatures will be cool this week across the north and warm across the south, focused most on the southern plains although that region will see a brief cooling with thunderstorms late this weekend. After a few weaker systems fade on the same eastward trek from plains into the southern Corn Belt, a welcome 1-2 day warmth will surge north and east to northern Plains and Corn Belt next week to be squelched by thunderstorms by weekend..

- *Corn Belt*: <u>Corn Belt</u> Another wet system traverses the Corn Belt regions today with weaker follow up mainly southern Corn Belt this weekend and Monday. Welcome warmth surges north and east next week before thunderstorms and cool front by the weekend. <u>Corn</u>, <u>Beans</u>
- *Spring Wheat Area*: <u>Northern Plains</u> Mainly dry and chilly this week before beneficial warming this weekend into next week with some showers and thunderstorms middle of next week. <u>Spring Wheat</u>
- *HRWW Area*: in <u>Southern Plains</u> Storms rumbling northeast TX this morning. Next wave Sunday with most rain NE, nrn KS. Heat returns this weekend TX,.OK pushing north next week (with some triple digit heat TX, OK). *Winter Wheat*
- *Delta*/ *Southeast*: Hot today then showers this weekend Heat builds (mid 90s) next week. Deep South remains warm and dry. *Cotton, Beans, Corn*

International Highlights

- In <u>Europe</u>, storm track from southwest to northeast means wettest across the north, driest and warmest in south and southeast then turning cooler in the east this weekend as it warms southwest. In <u>Russia</u>, North Russia, Belarus and west Ukraine and south Russia had good rains last week. More rains in western Ukraine into northern Russia this week. After cooling with brief cold front this weekend, warming in eastern Ukraine and much of Russia next week. <u>Poland Wheat</u>, <u>Germany Wheat</u>, <u>Ukraine Wheat</u>
- In <u>China</u> Showery and cool in much of Manchuria including Heilongjiang, the top spring wheat province which was in need of rain. Heaviest rains deep southeast. Warm and dry NCP ideal for maturing and harvesting wheat. Next chance showers early next week. *Winter Wheat, Corn*
- In *Australia*, all wheat areas taking their turns with showers. Queensland south to New South Wales and Victoria last week then South Australia and Victoria the last five days and Western Australia yesterday and today moving east next few days. *Winter Wheat*
- Dry and normal to cool this week <u>Argentina</u>. Showers northeast next week. In <u>Brazil</u> most of showers in south, Parana and Sao Paulo wettest. Vigorous wave next week same areas but extending down to Rio Grande do Sul. <u>Brazil Corn, Wheat, Coffee</u>, Argentina <u>Wheat</u>
- The African Ivory Coast and Ghana has seeing slowly increasing shower activity with monsoon slowly lifting north to dry areas. More rains the next two weeks as the cocoa mid-crop advances to harvest and the flowering of the main crop begins.
- Canada has been persistently much too cool (more than 10 degrees below normal in parts of Manitoba since April) and in the west too dry in Alberta. Concern grows about spring wheat and Canola. See story on the cold's effects said to be the worst in at least 15 years on canola crop in key canola province of Saskatchewan here. More seasonable next week into prairies. Spring Wheat, Canola
